

DOUBLE MAJOR IN SCIENCE APPLICATION

A Double Major in Science is available to students in a BSc Majors program. Students in the Double Major programs must satisfy all degree requirements of one department, including all Faculty of Science requirements. As far as the second department is concerned, you only need to satisfy all departmental requirements at the 300-level or higher, and any lower-level program requirements that are not part of the first major program. The second major may contain no more than 6 upper-level credits that are also counted toward the core requirements for the first major (i.e., double count).

Applications are accepted from the beginning of your third year, after you have been in your first Science Major for a year. Applications will not be accepted once you have been promoted to fourth year class standing. Entry into and continuation in a Double Major option requires that you remain in good academic standing with an average of at least a C (60%) in each term. You should be aware that in most cases it will not be possible to complete a Double Major in four years. All BSc degree requirements must be completed within a maximum of 180 attempted credits.

RESTRICTION: Not all combinations of majors are possible. If the area of one major lies within the field of the other major as defined in the Calendar, approval will not be granted.
